

STRATEGIC PLAN 2004-06

1. PROCESS

At the General Assembly in 2002 it was agreed that the Board of Directors would draw up a Strategic plan covering the next three years. It was proposed to review the Federation's objectives and look at how the global situation in which EFNDT operates has changed. It was then proposed to carry out a SWOT (Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Threats) analysis, which should identify gaps in the Federation's activities and develop specific strategies.

After a very constructive brainstorming at the BoD meeting in Glasgow in May 2003 a draft plan was prepared for circulation first to the full Board of Directors and then to the full membership ahead of the General Assembly meeting in Prague in November 2003. The GA then approved the plan and defined a series of Working Groups to prepare Action Plans. The Action Plans were refined and approved by the Board of Directors at its meeting in Moscow in March 2004.

2. SITUATION ANALYSIS

This analysis led to a consensus on a number of important changes in the scenario in which EFNDT and its member societies operate:-

(i) safety (personal and environmental) places increasingly important demands on NDT in service as well as in-manufacture and also requires increased promotion of the benefits of NDT.

(ii) NDT business in all its aspects is tending to be "globalised" and subject to standards, directives and regulations which are determined outside national boundaries. These are sometimes European (e.g. PED), sometimes sectoral (e.g. NADCAP) and sometimes international (e.g. ISO, IAEA, IAF ..).

(iii) the breadth and depth of technologies encompassed by NDT is increasing and many member societies now cover condition monitoring and diagnostic technologies as well as traditional NDT.

3. STRENGTHS AND WEAKNESSES OF EFNDT

It is considered that EFNDT is now established and respected to the point where it can provide a stable platform for more effective representation for the benefits of its

membership, particularly with greater engagement of the members. More involvement with the NDT societies of Eastern Europe is needed and also greater promotion of the contribution EFNDT can make to standards committees or authorities and regulatory bodies in all sectors concerned with safety.

EFNDT's role as a Federation of societies is complementary to the roles of individual member societies. Even in situations where members cannot find a consensus EFNDT has a role to play in providing a forum for information, debate and discussion so that individual members are fully informed.

4. OPPORTUNITIES FOR EFNDT

It was considered that the largest single opportunity relates to more extensive use of the EFNDT website as an information portal linked to member societies websites to share knowledge across national boundaries between individuals in NDT and those outside NDT who need information. Other opportunities identified for further discussion included:-

- (i) creation of a database of European NDT books and courses in a variety of European languages for training at all levels (school, college, university, technician, and professional)
- (ii) an EFNDT approval system for personnel certification bodies and
- (iii) creation of EFNDT Guidelines "documents", published on the website, on key topics (e.g. In-Service Inspection, Training guidelines for new technologies ...).

5. KEY STRATEGIES

The key strategies which are emerging from the situation analysis and the review of strengths, weaknesses and opportunities are:-

- (i) Improved use of Internet technologies including an intelligent NDT information portal, databases/libraries of training handbooks/courses, increased use of internet for intra-EFNDT communications and an Internet discussion Forum.
- (ii) Involvement of EFNDT in external bodies including the promotion of EFNDT to a wider group of organisations, more proactive involvement in key organisations, and continue strong links to NDT Societies outside Europe, mostly via ICNDT.
- (iii) Refocus attention on overall NDT quality system, develop better understanding by employees of the role of accreditation, qualification and job specific training, and recognise quality issues for new technologies.
- (iv) Promotion of NDT for Safety purposes including promotion to international bodies, governments and to the public. Promotion also of the broader scope of modern NDT (in-service inspection, materials testing, condition monitoring, anti-terrorism diagnostics, environmental diagnostics).
